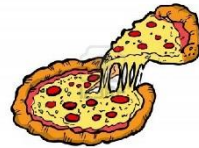


### English

Our English work this term will be based on 'Born to Run' by Michael Morpurgo. Through the issues which are highlighted in the book, we will develop these strong SMSC links through our writing techniques in diary writing, newspaper articles, non-chronological reports, descriptions and persuasion. We will continue to work on our spelling and grammar alongside this, and participate in the odd debate over the issues in the book!

### Art/DT

We will be working on architecture this half term, before a final DT unit on pizza making.



### RE

This term, we will be looking at the Buddhist faith to complete the year's work within this subject. This will begin with looking at the story of the Buddha, and his origins.

### Music

Musical learning will focus on beat and composition this term.

### Science

Class 5 really enjoy their scientific learning; this will continue with a unit on teeth and the digestive system. We will also be increasing our use of scientific vocabulary, and improve on our investigative skills.

### Maths

We will continue to develop our application of the written calculation methods; this forms a key part of basic mathematical learning. Our learning will also include looking at place value, fractions, measurement in the form of length, decimals, perimeter and area, and of course, the four main methods: addition, subtraction, division and multiplication. Maths targets and times tables remain prominent, as well as one or two pieces of homework per week.

### PE

This term we are returning to sports with SAFC now that we have finished swimming for the year. We will also be carrying out a unit on rounders and tennis before athletics and games after half term.

### Humanities

We will be looking into the Anglo-saxons in more detail this half term, before beginning work on ordinance survey maps and biomes in Geography.
