

Literacy

This term we will be continuing with the Read, Write Inc phonics programme. We will be learning to blend sounds to read green words and will learn red words by heart (You can't Fred a red!). We will be listening to and discussing lots of traditional tales including The Gingerbread Man and Jack and the Beanstalk.

In writing we will be continuing to practise our letter formation and using our 'Fred Fingers' to segment and spell words.

Physical Development

This term we will be working hard to practise for our whole school dance assembly. You will not fail to be impressed!

We will also be continuing to use the challenge cards in the outdoor area to help us develop our fitness and building on from our keeping healthy topic.

Mathematics

This term we will be learning to read and write numbers to 10 and beyond. We will also be learning about capacity and comparing objects by length and height. Later in the term we will begin to learn about addition and using related vocabulary. We will also be learning to order numbers from the smallest to the largest.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be working in small groups to create our own rockets throughout our Space topic this term. We will also be making our own rockets individually in the cut and stick area.

Understanding the World

As part of our Space topic, we will be investigating light and dark.

We will be reading the story Jack and the Beanstalk and will be growing our very own beanstalks. We will also be learning about the different parts of a plant and the things a plant needs to grow.

We will be looking at the Christian festival of Easter. We will be listening to the Easter story and learning how Christians celebrate this festival.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This term we will be using Fred Frog during circle time to encourage children to take turns, listen and value the opinions of others. We will be developing our confidence when speaking in a group and we will be discussing what makes a good friend.

We are continuing to practise lots of self-help skills this term as we learn to be more independent: dressing and undressing, fastening coats and washing our hands carefully.
