

English

In English this term, we will begin by looking at books by Julia Donaldson. We will start with Room on the Broom, before moving onto The Gruffalo, The Gruffalo's Child and Stick Man. Our writing will be based around this. We will also be looking at Monster's Zoo and The Man on the Moon. We will continue with Read, Write, Inc. sessions three times a week to continue our progress in phonics.

RE

This term, we will be exploring Christianity. We will be looking at churches, and what we can learn about Christianity from them. We will have the opportunity to visit a local church towards the end of the first half term. We will also be finding out about Harvest, and discovering what Harvest time means to Christians.

Music

In music, we are exploring different sounds, starting with how we can use our voices expressively. As we are continue through the term, we are going to focus on beat and pitch and explore various ways we can make sounds.

Computing

This term in computing, we are looking at programming. We are going to begin by programming a toy to hunt for treasure, using different algorithms.

Art/DT

For the first half term, we will be looking at portraits. We will explore a variety of portrait artists, such as Picasso and Warhol. We will learn different styles and techniques to create portraits. In the following half term, we will move on to our D&T topic and look at moving pictures, creating moving pictures based on traditional tales.

Maths

In Maths, we will begin with looking at place value, writing and ordering numbers up to 20, before progressing to 100 later in the term. We will be looking at addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will be exploring properties of shapes before moving onto position and direction. We will also be looking at measuring length and height and money.

PE

In P.E. this term, we will look at playing ball games. We will enjoy building our team working skills by playing in teams and small groups. We will also focus on our throwing and catching skills.

Humanities

We will begin the year with Geography aspects of the Humanities. We will be looking at the United Kingdom, and learning about each country of the UK. In the following half term, we will begin our history topic, looking at Guy Fawkes and the Gunpowder Plot.
