

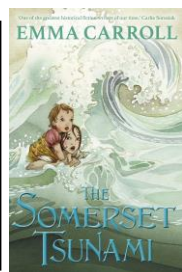
English

In Computing this half term, we will be learning about E-Safety and how we can be responsible and safe online.

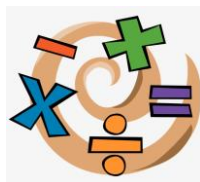


Maths

Art/DT
