EYFS/KS1	No statutory foreign language teaching required, however an understanding that many different languages are spoken around the world and an exposure to some basic language where it suitably enhances learning gives children a good foundation before studying a language in more detail. Basic greetings, counting and singing in another language are just some examples of how children can be introduced to MFL from a very young age. Pupils in nursery, reception and KS1 begin developing their cultural awareness across other subject areas such as Diwali in nursery, Africa in reception and a history topic on Florence Nightingale at the Crimean War in KS1.
