Computing

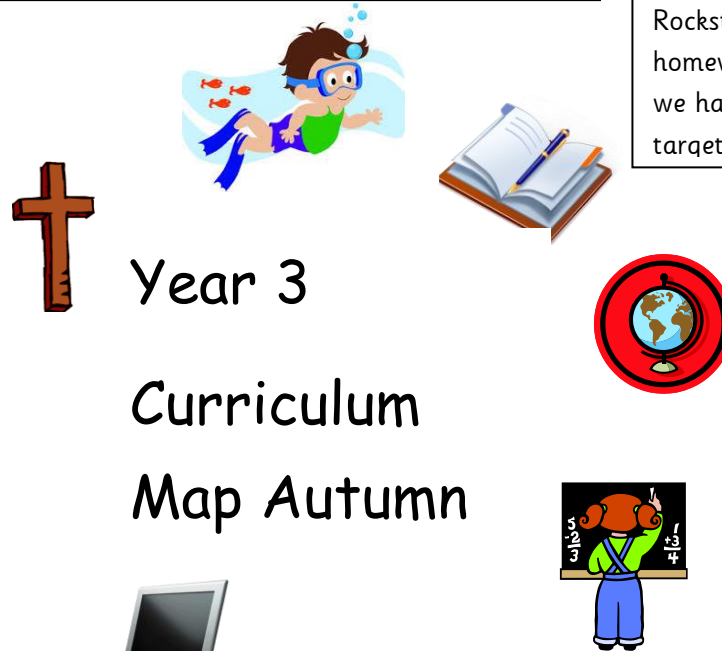
To start with, we will be learning about different computing systems and networks. We will be looking at different input and output devices.
